Driving Directions to Normanna Hall, Tacoma

In Tacoma

Two story brick building on the corner of S. 15th Street and Martin Luther King Way

Northbound from Olympia on I-5

Exit 132 to SR 16. Exit on Sprague. Follow Sprague. Turn right on S. 15th Street and follow to Martin Luther King Way. Two story brick building on the corner of S. 15th Street and Martin Luther King Way

Southbound from Seattle on I-5

Exit 133 City Center. Go towards A St. but Exit on S. 15th Street. Follow 15th up to Martin Luther King Way. Two story brick building on the corner of S. 15th Street and Martin Luther King Way

Easbound from Gig Harbor

Take SR 16 to Tacoma. Exit on Sprague. Follow Sprague. Turn right on S. 15th Street and follow to Martin Luther King Way. Two story brick building on the corner of S. 15th Street and Martin Luther King Way
